 - b. Contact the veterinary services of the importing country to find out the export health conditions and obtain, where applicable, an import permit.
2. The personal details concerning the identities of the landowners are available at the land registry office of the Service Topographique of the DITTT. The collector must come with the address of the plot or simply find its location on the mapping tool present at the reception in order to accurately identify the plot. Each legal record costs 200 FCP and is issued immediately by the reception staff officer. Applications not made in person take longer to process.
