The estate of Chateau Hagen includes the mansion, Maison Taragnat, the stables and a two-hectare park. Acquired by the South Province in 1998, it was immediately listed as an historic asset to ensure the preservation of this highly symbolic site of New Caledonian heritage.

Today, this unique venue combines artistic and cultural features. Its history, its architecture and the botanical value of the site contribute to the development of the arts.

Throughout the year, exhibitions and cultural events are organised for the general public or as part of formal ceremonies.



One weekend a month, visitors can take advantage of a free admission to Chateau Hagen which hosts special events such as plays, dance shows, concerts, film screenings, visual art workshops, circus arts, conferences, reception of artists in residence, reception of classes and groups.
